Protecting Vulnerable People

Domestic Abuse:

- Ongoing provision of Sanctuary Scheme for high risk domestic abuse victims
- Expand J9 awareness initiative
- Awareness raising to encourage reporting, including a new schools project
- Perpetrator awareness & promoting referrals to services

Hate Crime:

- Development of Hate Crime reporting centre in Rochford
- Embed Hate Crime Strategy in both areas, including support for Hate Crime awareness campaigns
- Radicalisation Awareness training sessions for professionals
