 A Sub Group of the Castle Point and Rochford Community Safety Partnership – the multiagency Partnership, formed under Sections 5 - 7 of the Crime & Disorder Act, 1998, to reduce crime and disorder in the Borough.

Aims:

- o To reduce ASB in Castle Point identifying, and tackling, the causes within the Borough
- To tackle specific ASB problems, targeting areas and individuals in Castle Point as necessary
- To monitor repeat and vulnerable victims of ASB to ensure an effective partnership response

Actions

- Hold regular multi agency meetings
- Produce and distribute agreed actions following each meeting. These will be reviewed at the following meeting.
- Facilitate a multi agency problem solving approach to those individuals, areas or addresses causing the most issues.
- Accountable to the Castle Point Community Safety Partnership Steering Group.
