Sack collection

If you do not wish to subscribe to our wheeled bin collection service you can still purchase garden waste sacks.



Black sacks containing Garden Waste will NOT be collected



The Council only collect the official Castle Point garden waste sacks and NOT sacks from any other supplier.

- ✓ Sacks guaranteed to last up to 3 weeks while full
- ✓ Handles for easier tying
- ✓ £8.00 for 20 sacks

Bundled garden waste

- ✓ You can bundle together larger garden waste, e.g. hedge trimmings/logs. Cut to 1m (3') lengths and bundle together with string
- Max 2 bundles per collection

What can I put in my bin or sack?



Grass cuttings



Dead flowers & house plants



Old garden plants & weeds



Vegetable patch waste (not vegetable peelings)



Leaves



Windfall fruit



Twigs & hedge trimmings



Logs & branches



X Gravel / stones

- X Plant pots & seed trays
- X Plastic, glass or metal
- X Soil / compost / turf
- X Treated wood

X Kitchen waste (including vegetable peelings)

- X Pet waste
- X General refuse
