What services are covered by this privacy notice?

1. **Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver, Vehicle and Operator Licensing** – collection of personal data so we can determine whether or not a driver, vehicle owner or operator are a 'fit and proper person' to be the holder of a licence associated with the hackney carriage and private hire trade.
2. **Alcohol and Entertainment Licensing (under the Licensing Act 2003)** – the processing of applications for granting, variations and enforcing of a wide variety of licences, certificates, permits and notices across the Borough in accordance with the Licensing Act legislation.
3. **Gambling and Betting (under Gambling Act 2005)** - the processing of applications for granting, variations and enforcing of a wide variety of licences, certificates, permits and notices across the Borough in accordance with the Gambling Act legislation.
4. **All other Licences** - the processing of applications for granting, variations and enforcing of a wide variety of licences, certificates, permits and notices across the Borough in accordance with the relevant legislation.

What personal information do we hold?

The services above may use some or all the personal information below:

- Names, address and contact details
- Family relationships and friendships
- Date of Birth
- Employment and education details
- Health & Medical information
- Financial Details
- Licences and permits held
- Goods and services information
- Traffic offence information
- Case file information
- Business Activities
- Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) Data

- All documents pertaining to any application

We get most of this information from you, but we may also get some of this information about you from the police, other local authorities, and other government agencies, e.g. Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA), DBS, Department of Transport, Home Office.

How do we use your personal information?

We use your information to:

- Deliver the service, or handle your query;
- Process applications in accordance with legislation;
- Detect and prevent crime or fraud;
- Communicate with you;
- Book appointments.

Who else might we share your personal information with?

Sometimes we may need to share your information, but we will only do so where it is necessary or required by law. We will only share the minimum information for each circumstance. We may sometimes need to share some of your personal information with:

- Police
- Courts and Tribunals Judiciary
- Essex County Council
- All responsible authorities under the relevant legislation
- DVLA
- DBS
- HMRC
- Other Local Authorities
- National Anti-Fraud Network (NAFN)
- Your information may also be shared with any other body that demonstrates it has a right to your information for this purpose.

Who is the Data Controller for this processing?

Castle Point Borough Council is the Data Controller for this processing.

Where we are relying on your consent to use your personal information you have the right to withdraw this consent at any time by contacting dpo@castlepoint.gov.uk or calling 01268 882200 and advising which service you are using.

How long will we keep your personal information?

We will only use your personal information whilst delivering the service to you and to deal with any questions or complaints that we may receive about this unless the law requires us to keep it for a longer period. In practice, this means that your personal information may be retained for:

- **Alcohol and Entertainment** - We will keep your information whilst you have an active licence and for 6 years after the licence has been revoked at which point it will be disposed of securely.
- **Gambling and Betting** - We will keep your information whilst you have an active licence and for 6 years after the licence has been revoked at which point it will be disposed of securely.
- **Hackney Carriage (Taxis) and Private Hire** - We will keep your information whilst you have an active licence and for 6 years after the licence has been revoked at which point it will be disposed of securely.

Where we revoke a driver licence the name and details as to why will be held on record indefinitely.



- **All other Licences** - We will keep your information whilst you have an active licence and for 6 years after the licence has been revoked at which point it will be disposed of securely.

Will my personal data be held or used outside of the United Kingdom?

No personal information is routinely sent or held outside the UK. Should the transfer of personal information outside of the UK become necessary, it will only take place if permitted by law, and then only where there are appropriate safeguards in place to protect the data.
