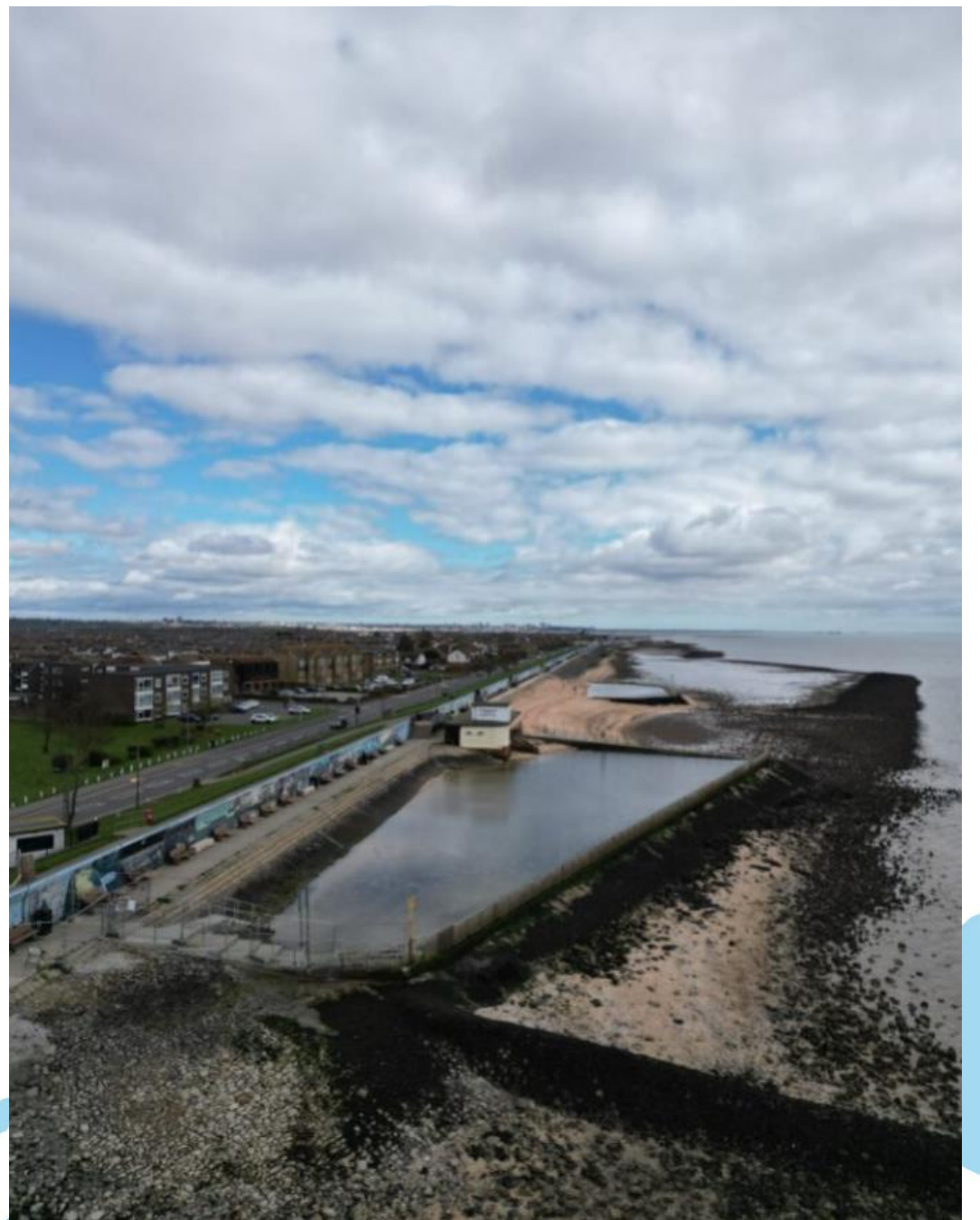

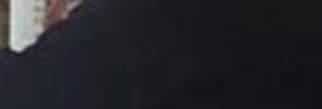


The work will be carried out in phases which are spread over the winter in the community and the island. The first phase is the most important. These phases are also being carried out in the most important designations on the eastern side of the island.

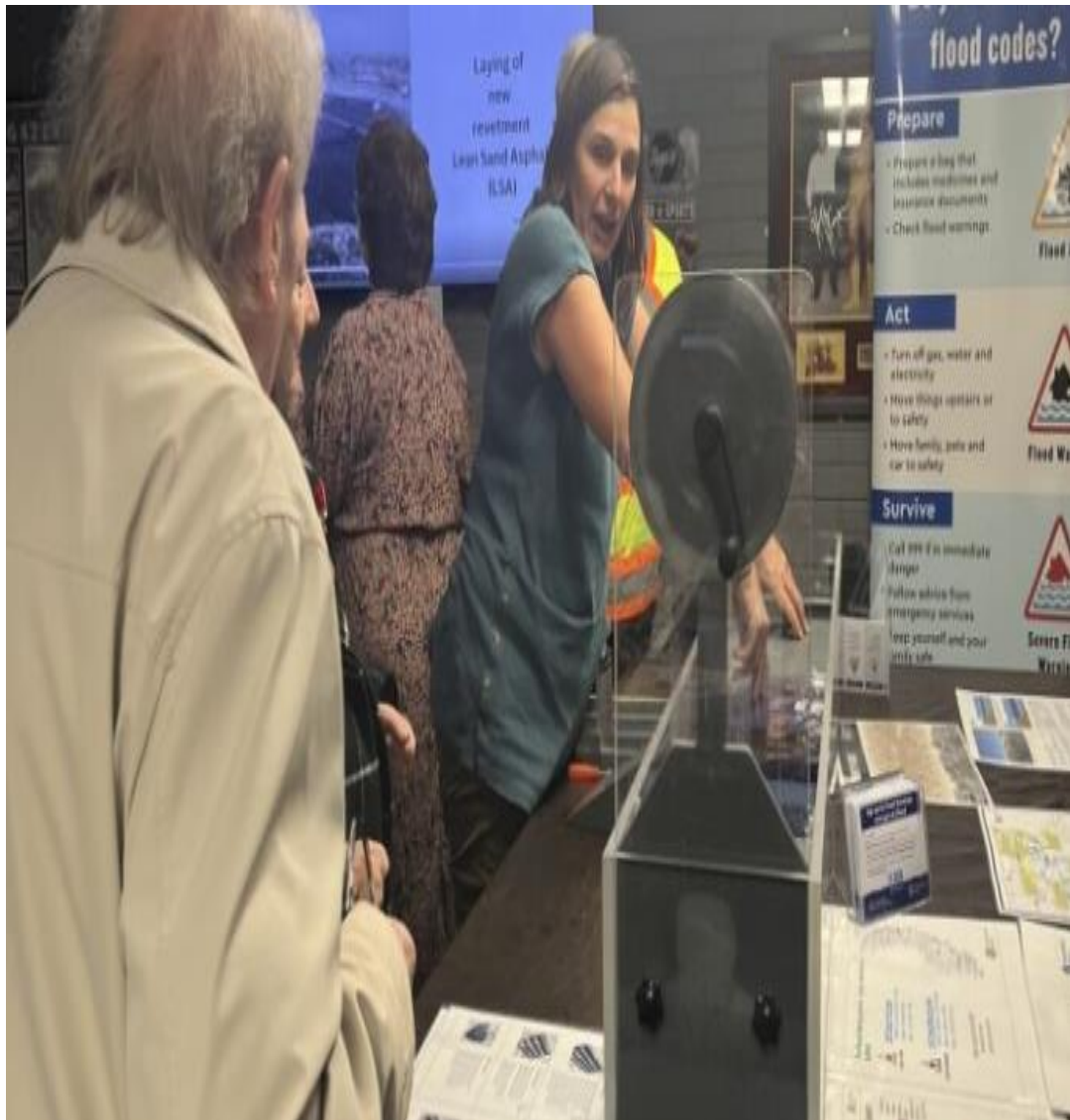
