



Revocation of Recreational Disturbance Avoidance and Mitigation Strategy (RAMS) Supplementary Planning Document – 2020

In accordance with Regulation 15 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) which remain in effect in accordance with the provisions of schedule 1 of the [Levelling-up and Regeneration Act 2023](#) ([Commencement No.11 and Saving and Transitional Provisions](#)) Regulations 2026, Notice is hereby given that the Recreational Disturbance Avoidance and Mitigation Strategy (RAMS) Supplementary Planning Document December 2020 is revoked.

The reason for revocation is that the content of the document is no longer fully aligned with the 2026 revised RAMS Strategy, evidence base and tariff.

The recommendation to revoke was approved by the Council on 22 July 2026 and takes effect from 1 August 2026.

As required under Regulation 15, following the revocation of the SPD, all physical and digital copies of the document will no longer be available, effective from 1 August 2026.
