Castle Point Borough Council are inviting comments on a New Local Plan from Wednesday 4 July to Wednesday 15 August 2018.

Local Plan 2018

A new Local Plan is required to set out how development and growth requirements in the administrative area covered by Castle Point Borough Council will be met over the next 15 years. The current Local Plan covering the area was adopted in 1998 and is now out of date. Previous work to prepare a new local plan effectively stalled in 2016, when a Plan was withdrawn from the examination process. The 2016 Plan was however supported by a substantial evidence base and was informed and reflected ongoing public consultation.

The purpose of this consultation is to seek the views of the public, stakeholders and other interested parties on what a new Plan should contain, with reference to previous documentation and evidence.
